## TARARUA ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD.

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

*Housing Loan, £1,650.*

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Electric-power Boards' Act, 1925, and the Statutes Amendment Act, 1938, the Tararua Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of £1,650, authorized to be raised under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of building two cottages in Eketahuna for the accommodation of certain members of the Board's staff, the said Tararua Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-fiftieth of one penny in the pound (1/50d. in the £) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in power district comprising the Boroughs of Pahiatua and Eketahuna, the Counties of Pahiatua, Eketahuna, Mauriceville, and Akitio; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the first day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years or until the loan is fully paid off."
