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TE KUITI BOROUGH COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Streets Improvements Loan, 1938.

AT a meeting of the above council held on the 27th February, 1939, the following resolution was passed:—

“In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Te Kuiti Borough Council hereby resolves as follows: That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of five thousand pounds (£5,000) authorized to be raised by the Te Kuiti Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of reconditioning and sealing various streets within the borough, the said Te Kuiti Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one and three-sixteenths of a penny (1 $\frac{3}{16}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all the rateable property within the Borough of Te Kuiti; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twelve (12) years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
