IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Marton Borough Council on the fourteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, in so far as it affects the portion and side of the street described in the Schedule hereto, viz. :—

“The Marton Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the Borough of Marton, hereby by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of the street known as Grey Street, adjoining Lots 89, 90, and part 91 on deposited plan number 14, part of Section 17, Rangitikei Agricultural Reserve, Town of Marton”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the western side of the portion of Grey Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

SCHEDULE.

THE western side of all that portion of street, situated in the Wellington Land District, Borough of Marton, known as Grey Street, fronting Lot 89, D.P. 14, being part Section 17, Rangitikei Agricultural Reserve. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 103859, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon edged red.
