“ That the New Plymouth Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the street hereinafter mentioned, hereby resolves and declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight, subsection one, of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of the western side of James Lane to which Lot 11 and part Lot 12, deposited plan 1271, Storehouse Reserve, New Plymouth, have frontages ” ;

subject to the condition that no shop or other building with a public entrance to James Lane, and no show-windows fronting James Lane displaying wares for sale, shall at any time be erected or permitted to be used on the land fronting the western side of the portion of James Lane (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said street.
