A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance of the power and authority conferred upon me by section nine of the Housing Act, 1919, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke, in so far as it relates to the land described in the Schedule hereto, the Proclamation dated the ninth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, and published in *Gazette* No. 67 of the fifteenth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, page 2034, setting apart the said land for the purposes of Part I of the said Act.
