M. A. Blackadder under and by virtue of a reserve lease for twenty-one years from the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen), is hereby taken for the purposes of a roadman's cottage and that the estate of leasehold in the land described in the Second and Third Schedules hereto (held from His Majesty the King by Walter James Patrick Williams under and by virtue of a renewable lease for sixty-six years from the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen), is hereby taken for the purposes of a quarry and road respectively; and I do also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twenty-second day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the eleventh day of October, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 79 of the third day of the following month, at page 2299, and deposited in the Land Registry Office at Gisborne as No. 785, taking land for the purposes of a police-station in Block V, Te Kaha Survey District, in so far as it affects the area of 13 perches mentioned in the Schedule thereto.
