In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Otaki Borough Council on the twenty-eighth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine (the portions of street affected by such resolution being more particularly described in the Schedule hereto), viz.:—

"That the Otaki Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the Borough of Otaki, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that part of Rangiuru Road, Otaki (shown on the undermentioned Certificate of Title as Rauparaha Street, Otaki), upon which abuts that piece of land containing one acre one rood twenty-four and two-tenths perches (1 acre 1 rood 24·2 perches) being part of Otaki A No. 59N and being also Lot 2 on Deposited Plan No. 7938, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title, Vol. 353, folio 69, Wellington Register";

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the northwestern side of the portions of Rangiuru Road (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said street.

Vesting the Control of a Scenic Reserve in the Matamata County Council.

GALWAY, Governor-General.
