IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Dunedin City Council on the seventeenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, viz. :—

“That the Dunedin City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Dunedin, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of The Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the south-eastern side of portion of Pennant Street abutting on Lot A and R.O.W., L.T.P. 1012, Township of Broughton”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the south-eastern side of the portion of Pennant Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

WHEREAS by Order in Council made on the twenty-second day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, consent was given to the raising in New Zealand by the Buller County Council (hereinafter called “the said local authority”) of the sum of fourteen thousand pounds (£14,000) by a loan to be known as “Road Improvements Loan, 1938” (hereinafter called “the said loan”), such consent being given subject to the determinations as to borrowing and repayment therein set out (including, *inter alia*, the provision that the rate of interest that might be paid in respect of the said loan or any part thereof should be such as should not produce to the lender or lenders a rate or rates exceeding three pounds ten shillings (£3 10s.) per centum per annum):
