

*Controlling Local Authorities appointed under Section 63 of the Licensing Act, 1908.*

GALWAY, Governor-General.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section 63 of the Licensing Act, 1908, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby appoint the local authorities named in the Schedule hereunder to be controlling local authorities under the said Act, to have authority for the purposes of the said Act throughout the licensing districts respectively named in the said Schedule, opposite the name of each such local authority respectively, and to make all necessary appointments and to do all things required for the conduct of elections of Licensing Committees, and for the general administration of the said Act within such licensing districts respectively.
