THEREAS the Dannevirke Hospital Board (hereinafter called "the said local authority") is desirous of raising the sum of four thousand pounds by a loan to be known as "Building Loan, 1939" (hereinafter called "the said loan"), for the purpose of installing a new boiler, enlarging the boiler-house and providing sundry equipment and storage-accommodation for coal, and has complied with the pro-visions of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), and it is expedient that the precedent consent of the Governor-General in Council as required by the said Act should be given to the raising of the said loan:
