to be trustees of the Arrows-town Public Cemetery as described in the Schedule hereto and to have the control and management of the said cemetery.

ARROWS-TOWN PUBLIC CEMETERY.

ALL that area in the Otago Land District, containing by admeasurement 2 acres 0 roods 10 perches, more or less, being Sections 12 and 13, Block XIX, Town of Arrows-town; Section 12 (area, 1 acre 2 roods) bounded, towards the north-west by a public road, 300 links; towards the north-east by Durham Street, 500 links; towards the south-east by a public road, 300 links; and towards the south-west by Section 11, 500 links. Section 13 (area, 2 roods 10 perches) bounded, towards the north-west by a public road, 300 links; towards the north-east by Durham Street, 187 links; towards the south-east by Section 10, 300 links; and towards the south-west by Section 11, 187 links: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less. As the same is more particularly shown on the plan marked 191/2/556, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Health, at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.
