RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and the Rural Housing Act, 1939, and all other acts and powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Thames County Council hereby resolves:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, repayment of principal, and other charges on the Thames County Rural Housing Loan, £10,000, 1940, to be raised by the Thames County Council for the purpose of relending to farmers for rural housing under the Rural Housing Act, 1939, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of five hundred one-thousandths of a penny in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the County of Thames; and the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable on the thirtieth days of March and September in each and every year during the currency of such loan being a period of 25 years or until the loan is fully paid off."
