HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto was acquired in part exchange for an area reserved as a site for a gravel-pit under the authority of an Order in Council dated the sixth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and two, and published in *Gazette* of the ninth day of that month, the said Order in Council having been issued pursuant to the provisions of section four of the Public Reserves Act, 1881, and section three of the Public Reserves Act Amendment Act, 1889:

And whereas on completion of such exchange the said land became vested in the Mount Peel Road Board but is now vested in the Mackenzie County Council, in trust, as a site for a gravel-pit:

And whereas it is expedient that the vesting of the said land as hereinbefore referred to should be cancelled, and the Mackenzie County Council has duly consented to such cancellation:

Now, therefore, His Excellency, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by subsection one of section ten of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, doth hereby cancel the vesting in the Mackenzie County Council of the land described in the Schedule hereto.
