THE CENTRAL WAIKATO ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Electric-power Boards' Act, 1925, and all other Acts and powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Central Waikato Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the principal, interest, and other charges on the Central Waikato Electric-power Board's Raglan Special Area (No. 2) Loan, 1940, £13,000, authorized to be raised by the Board under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of constructing and erecting transmission lines, transformer stations, and all fittings and appliances for conveying, transmitting, and distributing electricity, including the purchase of all necessary land, buildings, material, plant and tools, and all payments for labour, engineers' fees, plans and supervision, and for compensation to owners of property in respect of such works, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of three-fifths of a penny (¾d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) on all rateable property in the said special area comprising—

"(a) That portion of the County of Raglan included in the Central Waikato Electric-power District by Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on December 21st, 1938, at page 2813, as amended and altered by Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on July 27th, 1939, at page 2042:

"(b) That portion of the County of Raglan included in the Central Waikato Electric-power District by Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on June 22nd, 1939, at page 1848:

"and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the said loan and be payable on the 1st day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan being a period of twenty-six (26) years or until it is fully paid off."

We certify that the above is a correct copy of a resolution passed at a duly convened meeting of the Central Waikato Electric-power Board held on the 13th day of November, 1940.
