Position : 300° 6 cables from lighthouse. Lat., 36° 26' 5 S.; long. 175° 47' E. (approx.).

Abridged description : Fog W/T.

Details : A radio fog-signal has been established in the above position. Wave 294.5 kc/s (1018.7 m). Type : A2. Power : 60 m.-a.

ZLOV (— — — — —)	once, followed by a succession of V's	45 sec.
Long dash (— — — — —)	..	10 sec.
Repetition of ZLOV and V's	..	45 sec.
Long dash (— — — — —)	..	10 sec.
Silent	250 sec.

Period 360 sec. (6 min.)

Times of transmission : During weather of poor visibility, between 6 a.m. and sunset, the signal group will be transmitted every six minutes, commencing at 02 minutes past the hour.

During clear weather, between 6 a.m. and sunset, two complete transmissions of the signal group will be made every hour commencing at 02 and 32 minutes.

During all weather, between sunset and 6 a.m., the signal group will be transmitted as in weather of poor visibility.
