## WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL.

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

*Wellington City Paving and Surface Sealing Loan, 1927, Renewal Loan, 1941.*

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on Monday, the 2nd December, 1940:—

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and its amendments, and of all other Acts, powers, and authorities enabling it in that behalf, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a special loan of sixty-one thousand nine hundred pounds (£61,900) to be known as the Wellington City Paving and Surface Sealing Loan, 1927, Renewal Loan, 1941, authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of repaying to the extent that sinking funds are insufficient the Wellington City Paving and Surface Sealing Loan, 1927, of one hundred and sixty-one thousand pounds (£161,000) which matures in London on the 1st day of March, 1941, the Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one hundred and sixty-two eight-hundredths of a penny ( $\frac{162}{1000}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the City of Wellington; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of five (5) years from the 1st day of March, 1941, or until the loan is fully paid off."
