IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Main Highways Board on the twentieth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty, viz.:

“The Main Highways Board, being the local authority having control of the No. 52 Blenheim-Nelson Main Highway, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the eastern side of the portion of the said highway fronting part Section 1, District of Suburban North, Block IX, Wakapuaka Survey District”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the eastern side of the portion of the Blenheim-Nelson Main Highway (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of road.
