Hutt Valley Milk Delivery Scheme 1940 approved.

Office of the Minister of Supply,
Wellington, 18th December, 1940.

PURSUANT to Regulation 3 of the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1940, the Minister of Supply, being satisfied that all the vendors of milk (otherwise than by sale over the counter) in the district specified in the scheme referred to in the Schedule hereto are parties to the scheme or have been given an opportunity of becoming parties thereto, doth hereby approve the said scheme.

SCHEDULE.

HUTT VALLEY MILK DELIVERY SCHEME 1940.

1. For the purposes of the scheme—

“The commodity” means milk, and includes cream:

“The district” means Petone Borough, Lower Hutt Borough, and portion of the Hutt County, as delineated by the demarcation of zones on the plan:

“The plan” means the plan of the district deposited for the purposes of the scheme in the Head Office of the Transport Department at Wellington under No. 1180.

2. The scheme shall come into operation on the day following the date of the publication in the *Gazette* of notice of the approval of the scheme by the Minister of Supply.
