WHEREAS it has been found desirable for the use, convenience, and enjoyment of the Clarksville to Lawrence Branch of the Waitaki-Bluff Railway to take further land at Johnstone in addition to land previously acquired for the purposes of the said railway:

Lawrence Branch of the Waldar-Doull Kalway to take further land at Johnstone in addition to land previously acquired for the purposes of the said railway: Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by sections thirty-four and two hundred and sixteen of the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes above mentioned.

SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land : 11 perches. Portion of road.

Situated in Block V, Waitahuna East Survey District, Tuapeka County. (S.O. W. 215.)

In the Otago Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L.O. 6019, deposited in the office of the Minister of Railways at Wellington, and thereon coloured green.
