RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

The Masterton County Workers' Dwelling Loan of £1,500, 1939.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf, by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Masterton County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, principal, and other charges on the Masterton County Workers' Dwelling Loan of £1,500, 1939, authorized to be raised by the Masterton County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of acquiring the necessary land, the erection of a worker's dwelling thereon, and all other charges incidental thereto, the said Masterton County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one one-hundred-and-fortieth (1/140d.) of one penny in the pound sterling, on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the whole of the County of Masterton; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring special rate during the currency of the said loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of July in each year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”
