

Now, therefore, the Waipawa County Council, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on the Council by section 23 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, hereby resolves that the said special rate of seventeen-hundredths of a penny ($\frac{17}{100}$ d.) in the pound shall be and is hereby amended by increasing such amount of seventeen-hundredths of a penny ($\frac{17}{100}$ d.) in the pound to nineteen-one-hundredths of a penny ($\frac{191}{1000}$ d.) in the pound.

PERIA RABBIT BOARD.

RESOLUTION LEVYING SPECIAL RATE.

Moved by Mr. McNaul.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and its amendments, and of all other powers and authorities enabling it in that behalf, the Peria Rabbit Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest and sinking fund and other charges on the loan of six hundred pounds (£600), authorized to be raised by the said Peria Rabbit Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of erecting a worker's dwelling for the use of the Board's inspector on that piece of land being the eastern portion of Section 63, Block V, Tapapa Survey District, and the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title, Vol. 163, folio 36, Auckland Registry, the said Peria Rabbit Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-half of one penny per acre on all rateable property within the Peria Rabbit Board District; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable annually on the first day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

Seconded by Mr. Morgan, and carried.
