

RAGLAN COUNTY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Camping-grounds Loan, 1939.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Raglan County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the half-yearly instalments of principal and interest and other charges on a loan of £950, authorized to be raised by the Raglan County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of acquiring land at Port Waikato, laying-out a camping-ground, erecting any necessary buildings and equipment thereon, laying on a water-supply and surveying and roading the area, the said Raglan County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of -0126d. in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property comprising the whole of the County of Raglan; such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
