IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, and the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby authorize the Auckland City Council to permit the laying-off of the proposed street described in the Schedule hereto of a width less than sixty-six feet, but not less than forty feet, subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the said street within a distance of thirty-five feet from the centre-line of the said street.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Timaru Borough Council on the fifteenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and forty, viz.:—

“That the Timaru Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the Borough of Timaru, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of the northern side of the street known as Mere Mere Street fronting Lot 6, D.P. 12, Borough of Timaru”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the northern side of portion of Mere Mere Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Waimea County Council on the eighth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, viz.:—

“That the Waimea County Council, being the local authority having control over the roads within the Waimea County, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the northern side of the road fronting the southern boundary of part Sections 60 and 61, Motueka Original, Block X, Kaiteriteri Survey District, as shown on plan prepared by F. A. C. Staig, Registered Surveyor, and coloured red thereon. (H. O. Drummond)”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the portion of road (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-five feet from the centre-line of the said portion of road.
