IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Taieri County Council on the sixth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and forty (in so far as it affects the portion and side of road described in the Schedule hereto), viz.:—

“The Taieri County Council, being the local authority having control of the roads in the County of Taieri, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of Clyde Street, adjoining Sections 68, 69, and 70, Township of Mosgiel Junction”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the north-western side of portion of Clyde Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of road.

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the south-eastern side of the portion of Walton Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
