NOTICE is hereby given in pursuance of the Agricultural and Pastoral Societies Amendment Act, 1933, as amended by section 4 of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1936, of the making by the Kumeu District Agricultural and Horticultural Society on the 30th day of January, 1940, and of the approval by the Governor-General on the 13th day of March, 1940, of by-laws under the above-entitled Act, controlling the admission of persons to any place used or occupied by the said society for any meeting, show, exhibition, competition, or entertainment, held by the said society, which said by-laws came into force on the last-mentioned date.
