

Declaring Crown Land in the North Auckland Land District to be subject to the Land for Settlements Act, 1925.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "said land") is Crown land not acquired under the Land for Settlements Act, 1925, but is adjacent to certain land acquired under the said Act and known as the Puketū Settlement and can conveniently be disposed of therewith:

Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section one hundred and five of the said Act, and on the recommendation of the Dominion Land Purchase Board, and after considering the report of the North Auckland District Land Board, do hereby declare the said land to be subject to the said Act, to the intent that it shall hereupon be deemed to be portion of the said Puketū Settlement and may be disposed of accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT.—WHANGAROA COUNTY.

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 3 acres 0 roods 16 perches, more or less, being part of Section 5, Block XV, Kaeo Survey District, bounded: Towards the east by a public road 1730 links; and towards the south-west and north-west by Section 32, Block XV aforesaid, 1261.7 links and 654.8 links respectively.

Also all that area in Block XV, Kaeo Survey District, containing by admeasurement 10 perches, more or less, bounded: Towards the east by a public road 252.5 links; towards the south by part O.L.C. 15, 6.8 links; and towards the west and north-west by Section 21, Block XV aforesaid, 206.5 links and 68.1 links respectively. Be all the aforesaid admeasurements a little more or less.

As the same are more particularly delineated on plan marked L. and S. 21/166 "B," deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon bordered yellow. (North Auckland plan 23941 (3, 4).)
