RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Bridges Loan, 1938, £10,000.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Bay of Islands County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purposes of providing interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £10,000, authorized to be raised by the Bay of Islands County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of constructing (in concrete) bridges throughout the said county, the Bay of Islands County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three-eighths of a penny (¾d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the County of Bay of Islands; and that such rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the said loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
