The South-eastern Side of Portion of Pollock Street, and the South-western Side of Portion of Henry Street, in the City of Dunedin, exempted from the Provisions of Section 128 of the Public Works Act, 1928, subject to a Condition as to the Building-line.

"That the Dunedin City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Dunedin, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the undermentioned

portions of streets, viz.:—
"(a) The south-eastern side of portion of Pollock
Street, abutting on Lots 10, 11, and 12,
Deeds Plan 45, Township of Murrayville;

"(b) The south-western side of portion of Henry Street, abutting on Lot 12, Deeds Plan 45, Township of Murrayville";

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the southeastern side of the portion of Pollock Street and the southwestern side of the portion of Henry Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-lines of the said portions of streets.

SCHEDULE.

The south-eastern side of all that portion of street situated in the Otago Land District, City of Dunedin, known as Pollock Street, fronting Lots 10, 11, and 12, Deeds Plan 45, Township of Murrayville, and being parts Section 14, Block I, Upper Kaikorai District.

Also the south-western side of all that portion of street in the said land district and city, known as Henry Street, fronting Lot 12, Deeds Plan 45, Township of Murrayville, and being part Section 14, Block I, Upper Kaikorai District.

As the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 107196, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon edged red.
