NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND FOR ROAD-WIDENING IN DAERE TOWNSHIP.

In the matter of the Counties Act, 1920, and of the Public Works Act, 1928.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Southland County Council proposes under the above-mentioned Acts to execute a public work—namely, the widening of the Rakauhauka-Daere Main Highway where it joins the Invercargill-Dunedin State Highway on the northern side of the latter—and for the purposes of such public work the lands described in the Schedule hereto are required to be taken; and notice is hereby further given that a plan of the lands so required to be taken is deposited at the office of the Southland County Council in Tay Street, near Nith Street, Invercargill, and is there open for inspection by all persons (without fee) during ordinary office hours.

WAIPA COUNTY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by Part II of the Local Authorities Interest Reduction and Loans Conversion Act, 1932-33, section 20 of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1935, section 9 of the Local Legislation Act, 1938, and the Waipa County Loans Conversion Order, 1939, the Waipa County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the half-yearly instalments of principal and interest in respect of the new securities, authorized to be issued by the Waipa County Council under the above-mentioned Acts and Order, the said Waipa County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate on a uniform scale of 3.50d. in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within that area of its district which was formerly comprised in the Tua Tua Moana Drainage District immediately prior to the abolition of that district, as described in *New Zealand Gazette* of 16th March, 1916, at page 788, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such securities and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year until the last maturity date of such securities, being the 31st day of July, 1974, or until such securities are all fully paid off.”
