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## MASTERTON BOROUGH COUNCIL.

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Masterton Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of ten thousand five hundred pounds (£10,500), authorized to be raised by the Masterton Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of cleaning and concrete-lining the 10 in. and 12 in. mains from the reservoir to town and the 18 in. spiral steel main from the Upper Plain Reservoir to the intake, the said Masterton Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of eight-twenty-fifths of a penny ( $\frac{8}{25}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value, on the basis of the unimproved value, of all rateable property of the special rating-area comprising the whole of the Borough of Masterton; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the first day of December and the first day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”
