APPROXIMATE areas of the pieces of land proclaimed as road:—

LAND PROCLAIMED AS ROAD.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land proclaimed as road: 2 acres 0 roods 32.4 perches. Being portion of Lot 2, D.P. 24566, being part Sarah Hutton's Grant; coloured blue.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

ROAD CLOSED.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of road closed: 1 acre 2 roods 7.9 perches. Adjoining Lots 1 and 2, D.P. 24566, being part Sarah Hutton's Grant; coloured green.
