Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the said Act, do hereby permanently reserve the lands described in the Schedule hereto for the purposes in the said Schedule specified at the end of the respective descriptions of the lands so intended to be permanently reserved for which purposes the said lands were so temporarily reserved as aforesaid.

GISBORNE LAND DISTRICT.

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 2 acres 0 roods 11.7 perches, more or less, being Section 10 and part of Section 9, Tiniroto Village, Block XV, Hangaroa Survey District, and bounded as follows: Towards the north-west by Sections 12 and 13, distance 579.1 links, bearing 259° 23'; towards the south-west by a public road, distance 496.6 links, bearing 135° 10', and distance 89 links, bearing 169° 26'; towards the south-east by a public road, distance 300 links, bearing 79° 23'; towards the north-east by Section 24, distance 500 links, bearing 349° 26'; be all the aforesaid linkages more or less. GALWAY, Governor-General.

WHEREAS by the three-hundred-and-fifty-ninth section of the Land Act, 1924, it is enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time set apart temporarily as reserves, notwithstanding that the same may be then held under pastoral license, any Crown lands which in his opinion are required for any of the purposes in the said section mentioned:

Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the said Act, do hereby temporarily reserve the land in the North Auckland Land District, described in the Schedule hereunder written, for recreation purposes.

SCHEDULE.

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT.

ALL that area in the City of Auckland, containing by admeasurement 1 acre 1 rood 30 perches, more or less, being Section 24, Block VIII, Rangitoto Survey District. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 1/1073, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon bordered red. (North Auckland plan S.O. 31039.)
