

RAGLAN COUNTY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

*Kopua Camping-grounds Loan, 1940.*

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Raglan County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the half-yearly instalments of principal and interest and other loan charges on a loan of £1,550, authorized to be raised by the Raglan County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of laying out a camping-ground and children's play area on the Kopua Reserve, Raglan, erecting any necessary buildings and equipment thereon and surveying and roading the area, the said Raglan County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of .021d. in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property comprising the whole of the County of Raglan; such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”
