*Declaring a Bobby Calf Marketing Pool Area.*

**PURSUANT** to the Bobby Calf Marketing Regulations 1939, I, Walter Nash, Minister of Marketing, being satisfied that a sufficient majority of the producers in the area of land defined in the Schedule hereto are desirous that such area should be declared to be a pool area for the marketing of bobby calves, do hereby declare such area of land, defined as aforesaid, to be a Bobby Calf Marketing Pool Area for the purposes of the said regulations under the name set out in the said Schedule, and I do hereby declare that this notice shall take effect on the 1st day of August, 1940.

**SCHEDULE.****BROADWOOD BOBBY CALF MARKETING POOL AREA.**
