Notice restricting the Sale and Use of the Drug Sulphapyridine.

PURSUANT to the Medical Supplies Emergency Regulations 1939, I, Michael Herbert Watt, Medical Supplies Controller, do hereby require all owners of supplies of the drug 2-sulphanilylamino-pyridine, more commonly known under the names "sulphapyridine," "Dagenan-M. & B. 693," and "M. & B. 693," not to use, dispose of, part with the possession or control of, or otherwise deal with the said drug except in accordance with the following directions:—

- (a) The drug shall not be used except for the treatment of human ailments;
- (b) The drug shall not be sold by wholesale to any person except registered medical practitioners and registered pharmaceutical chemists;
- (c) The drug shall not be sold by retail except pursuant to a prescription signed by a registered medical practitioner.

THAT in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Noxious Weeds Act, 1928, the Waikato County Council hereby resolves and declares, by way of special order, that the plant known as pussy willow (*Salix caprea*) (being a plant mentioned in the Second Schedule to the said Act, as extended from time to time by the Governor-General in Council) is a noxious weed within the County of Waikato.
