WHEREAS the Grey County Council (hereinafter called VV "the said local authority") proposes, pursuant to the provisions of section three of the Main Highways Amendment Act, 1928, to borrow the sum of one thousand four hundred and sixty-seven pounds ten shillings (£1,467 10s.) by a loan to be known as "Main Highways Loan, 1940" (hereinafter called "the said loan"), for the purpose of paying its portion of the cost of constructing the Barrytown During on the Wortnert Comparison (Constructing the Barrytown Deviation on the Westport-Greymouth (Coast Road) Main Highway :
