ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, Bay of Islands County, containing by admeasurement 339 acres 3 roods 20 perches, more or less, being part of Section 1s, Puketi Settlement, situated in Blocks XIV and XV, Kaeo Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the south-east by Section 4s, a public road, and Section 3s, Puketi Settlement; and towards the north-west by a permanent State forest (*Gazette* 1927, page 2778, and *Gazette* 1933, page 3403); save and excepting an intersecting public road.
