BY virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the thirty-fourth section of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby order and declare that the reserves for recreation in the Auckland Land District described in the Schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby brought under the operation of and declared to be subject to the provisions of Part II of the said Act, and such reserves shall hereafter form part of the Ngatea Domain, and be managed, administered, and dealt with as a public domain by the Ngatea Domain Board.

Fixing the Date and Place for Payment of Land-tax and Income-tax under the Land and Income Tax (Annual) Act, 1940.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authority vested in him under the Land and Income Tax Act, 1923, and the Land and Income Tax (Annual) Act, 1940, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order and determine that the respective duties leviable under the said Acts by way of land-tax and income-tax shall be paid on the days and dates set forth hereunder :—

Land-tax under section 2 of the Land and Income Tax (Annual) Act, 1940 : In one sum on Tuesday, the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and forty.

Income-tax under section 3 of the Land and Income Tax (Annual) Act, 1940 : In one sum on Wednesday, the twelfth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.

And, in further pursuance and exercise of the powers and authority aforesaid, and with the like advice and consent as aforesaid, His Excellency doth also determine that the place where the said duties of land-tax and income-tax shall be payable shall be the office of the Commissioner of Taxes, Wellington, and that notice to the foregoing effect shall be given by the said Commissioner accordingly.
