IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Dunedin City Council on the third day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine (in so far as it affects the portion and side of Watts Road described in the Schedule hereto), viz. :-

"That the Dunedin City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Dunedin, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the undermentioned portions of streets, viz. :-

"(a) The south-eastern side of portion of Campbells Road, abutting on part Section 13, Block X, North Harbour and Blueskin District; and

"(b) The north-eastern side of portion of Watts Road, abutting on parts of Sections 13 and 15, Block X, North Harbour and Blueskin District";

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the north-eastern side of the portion of Watts Road (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
