“That the New Plymouth Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the streets herein-after mentioned, hereby resolves and declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of the northern side of Gaine Street to which Sections 196E, 196F, and 196G, New Plymouth, have frontages”;
