3. SYSTEM OF SUPPLY.

The system of supply shall be in accordance with paragraph (a) of clause 21–01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations, 1935. Supply shall be received from the Minister of Public Works at a nominal pressure of 400/230 volts alternating current at the licensee's sawmill premises at Miro Miro Station.

4. CHARGES ON SALE.

The charges for electrical energy shall not exceed one shilling (Is.) per unit for lighting purposes and sixpence (6d.) per unit for motor-power or heating purposes: Provided that "lighting purposes" shall include the operation of motor-generators for lighting purposes, and provided further that if accounts are paid within fourteen days of due date the charges shall not exceed 9d. per unit for lighting purposes and 4¹/₄d. per unit for motor-power or heating purposes.

5. DURATION OF LICENSE.

Unless sooner determined, this license shall continue in force until the 31st day of March, 1945, or until electrical energy is available from an Electric-power Board or other general public source, whichever is the earlier.
