WHEREAS by a Warrant dated the fourteenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, and published in the *Gazette* of the twenty-fourth day of that month, the control of a certain reserve in the Canterbury Land District, known as the Orari Gorge Scenic Reserve, was vested in certain persons therein named, who were by the said Warrant constituted a special Board by the name of the Orari Gorge Scenic Board, in pursuance of section thirteen of the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908: And whereas it is desirable that John Mather Polhill should be appointed a member of the said Board in place of Robert Yates, deceased:
