RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Water-meter Loan, 1941, £1,800.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Northcote Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purposes of providing the interest, principal, and other charges on a loan of one thousand eight hundred pounds (£1,800), authorized to be raised by the Northcote Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of purchasing and installing water-meters, the said Northcote Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of twenty-one hundredths of a penny (-21d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Northcote; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years or until the loan is fully paid off.”

The above resolution was carried at a special meeting of the Northcote Borough Council held on the 16th December, 1941.
