Declaring a Portion of Railway Land at Newmarket to be Crown Land.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by section thirty-five of the Public Works Act, 1928, it is provided that in the case of any land taken, purchased, or acquired for a Government work and not required for that purpose, the Governor-General may, on recommendation by the Minister by Proclamation, declare such land to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1924, and thereupon the land may be administered and disposed

of under that Act accordingly : Now, therefore, I, Sir Michael Myers, the Administrator of the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by section thirty-five of the Public Works Act, 1928, and of orem other power and arthresity in survivo employed and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1924.

SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land: 2 acres 1 rood 25.47 perches, being part Allotment 1 of Section 11, Suburbs of Auckland, on D.P. 26330.

Situated in Block VIII, Rangitoto Survey District, City of Auckland. (S.O. 31487.)

In the North Auckland Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L.O. 6437, deposited in the office of the Minister of Railways at Wellington, and thereon coloured orange.
