PURSUANT to the Harbours Act, 1923, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby vest in the Hokianga Harbour Board (hereinafter called "the Board," which term shall include its successors or assigns unless the context requires a different construction), the management of the wharves at Horeke, Kohukohu, Koutu, Motukaraka, Opononi, Rawene, Te Karaka (Panguru), Te Teo, and The Narrows in Hokianga Harbour, as shown on approved plans marked M.D. 2944; 1222, 1223, 3948; 2412; 3749, 4329; 1491, 1492; 181, 182, 582, 583, 3947, 4013; 6246; 4847; and 2505, 3896; and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, such vesting to be subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

1. The vesting is subject to the Foreshore License Regulations 1940, and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.

2. The term of the vesting shall be fourteen years from the 10th day of January, 1941.
