generally along the south-eastern boundaries of the said Pukeweka No. 17A Block to its south-western corner; thence by a right line to the south-eastern corner of Section 97, Fitzroy District; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of Section 97 aforesaid to its northernmost corner, the point of commencement.
