

in the Borough of Hawera, by providing and installing a filtration and treatment plant with all necessary fittings, and by providing and installing a six-inch water-main in Waihi Road and High Street with all necessary house connections and other requisites, and by reconditioning and lining the existing water-mains comprising the reticulation system of the borough, the said Hawera Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of five hundred and ninety-five one thousandths of a penny (595/1,000d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Borough of Hawera, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the first day of the month of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years or until the said loan is fully paid off."

##### RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

**I**N pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Collingwood County Council resolves as follows:—

"That for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £2,000, authorized to be raised by the Collingwood County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of making advances to farmers for the erection of dwellings under the Rural Housing Act, 1939, the said Collingwood County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-twentieth of one penny ( $\frac{1}{20}$ d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the Collingwood County comprising the whole of the County of Collingwood; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being for a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off."
