

(2) In lieu of a rate of interest not exceeding four pounds (£4) per centum per annum, as specified in clause two of the said Order in Council, the rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said loan shall be such as shall not produce to the lender a rate exceeding three pounds fourteen shillings (£3 14s.) per centum per annum.

(3) In lieu of repayment by equal aggregate annual or half-yearly instalments of principal and interest, as specified in clause three of the said Order in Council, the said loan shall be repaid as follows:—

(a) By fifty (50) equal payments of sixty-nine pounds six shillings and eightpence (£69 6s. 8d.), one of such payments to be made at the end of every half-year commencing from the date on which the said loan is raised. Each such half-yearly payment shall be applied firstly in payment of interest computed at the rate of three pounds fourteen shillings (£3 14s.) per centum per annum on the amount of the principal for the time being outstanding at the beginning of each such half-year, and the balance of such half-yearly payment in reduction of such principal.

(b) By a payment at the end of the twenty-fifth year from the date of the raising of the said loan of a sum equal to the amount to which the principal has been reduced in accordance with the preceding paragraph (a) hereof after payment of the aforesaid fifty (50) half-yearly payments.
