DURSUANT to the Harbours Act, 1923, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby license and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby license and permit James Walker and Frank Walker, both of Waihau Bay (hereinafter called the "licensees," which term shall include their executors, administrators, or assigns, unless the context requires a different construction), to use and occupy a part of the foreshore below low-water mark at Waihau Bay, as shown on plan marked M.D. 8075, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Welling-ton, for the purpose of maintaining thereon a wharf as shown on the said plan, such license to be held and enjoyed by the licensees upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the schedule hereto.
