*Allocating Railway Land to the Purposes of a Road in Block VIII, Rangitaiki Upper Survey District.*

 A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land which is described in the Schedule hereto (and which was taken for the East Coast Main Trunk Railway, Awakeri Section, and is not now required for such purpose) shall, upon the publication hereof in the *New Zealand Gazette*, become a road, and that such road shall be maintained by the Main Highways Board in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Board.
